Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Delightful Wishes, It's Okay
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Lemon Lolly, Old Olive, Very Vanilla, Floral Delight Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- **Stampin' Pads:** Lemon Lolly, Crushed Curry, Pecan Pie, Old Olive
- **Other:** Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Mini Glue Dots, Daffodil Delight 1/8" Satin Ribbon, cardboard

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Lemon Lolly:**
 - (card base/diagram A) 5 1/4" x 8 3/4"
 - (mini cards) (2) 3" x 6", score and fold at 3"
- **Old Olive:**
 - (mini card layers) (2) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"
 - (mini card layers) (2) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
 - (DSP layers) (7) 1 5/8" x 1 5/8"
- **Very Vanilla:** (stamped front image) (2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- **Designer Series Paper:**
 - 8 1/2" x 12"
 - (envelope) Cut to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"
 - (DSP layers) Cut remaining into (7) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- **Cardboard:** (envelope template/diagram C) 4 5/8" x 4 5/8" – cut in half to create (2) triangles

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Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Bottled Happiness, Timeless Arrangements
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Bubble Bath, Garden Green, Basic White, Delightfully Eclectic (DSP), cardboard
- **Stampin' Pads:** Bubble Bath, Garden Green, Moody Mauve
- **Other:** Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Sweet Sorbet Metallic Ribbon, Iridescent Rhinestones

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Bubble Bath:** 5 1/4" x 8 3/4" (Diagram A)
- **Garden Green:** (2) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"
 - (2) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
 - (7) 1 5/8" x 1 5/8"
- **Basic White:** (2) 3" x 6", score and fold at 3"
 - (2) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
- **Designer Series Paper:** 8 1/2" x 12" – cut to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"
 - Cut remaining into (7) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
- **Cardboard:** 4 5/8" x 4 5/8"

Card Instructions:

1. Follow the instructions on **DIAGRAM A** to create the card base.
2. Burnish all the score lines with a bone folder:
 - a. Burnish the (2) center score lines inward.
 - b. The top score will fold towards the back.
 - c. The bottom score will fold towards the front.
 - d. When the card is laying flat, it will look like **DIAGRAM B** with the bottom left panel on the front.
3. Adhere the (7) squares of DSP to the (7) squares of Garden Green cardstock. Adhere to the card base.
4. Adhere to the (2) 3" x 6" Basic White folded cards. These cards can open any way you want so adhere them in the direction you want them to be on the card.
5. Adhere to the (2) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" Garden Green cardstock.
6. Stamp the sentiment at the top of (1) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" Basic White. In Garden Green ink stamp the leaves on both pieces of Basic White. In Bubble Bath, stamp the flowers. Adhere these to the 3" x 3" cards.
7. Add a ribbon knot in the upper left corner of the card on the left side.
8. Close the card and add a few rhinestones as desired. Avoid adding them where the card folds as to not damage the card.
9. Create envelope with the 8 1/2" x 8 1/2" DSP following **DIAGRAM C**.



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Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Petal Park, Lasting Joy
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Azure Afternoon, Fresh Freesia, Berry Burst, Basic White, cardboard, White heavy weight copy paper (32 lb)
- **Stampin' Pads:** Memento Black, Tahitian Tide, Fresh Freesia, Berry Burst, Granny Apple Green
- **Other:** Petal Park Builder punch, Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Stampin' Pierce Mat, Tinsel Gems 3-Pack, Country Countryside Blossoms Embossing Folder

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Azure Afternoon:** 5 ¼" x 8 ¾" (Diagram A)
- **Berry Burst:** (2) 3" x 6", score and fold at 3"
 - 1/8" x 3"
- **Fresh Freesia:** (2) 2 ¾" x 2 ¾"
- **Basic White:** (2) 3 ¼" x 3 ¼"
 - (3) 2 ½" x 8 ½"
 - (7) 1 ½" x 1 ½"
- **Cardboard:** 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝"
- **Copy Paper:** 8 ½" x 8 ½"

Card Instructions:

1. Follow the instructions on **DIAGRAM A** to create the card base.
2. Burnish all the score lines with a bone folder:
 - Burnish the (2) center score lines inward.
 - The top score will fold towards the back.
 - The bottom score will fold towards the front.
 - When the card is laying flat, it will look like **DIAGRAM B** with the bottom left panel on the front.
3. Stamp 2-3 leaves in Memento Black and Granny Apple Green on the (7) squares of Basic White; adhere to the card base.
4. Lay the flower trio stamp side down on the punch and add to block. This will help you know how to punch them straight up and down. Stamp the outline (3) times one each 2 ½" x 8 ½" Basic White. Stamp the solid flower inside in Tahitian Tide, Fresh Freesia, and Berry Burst. Punch all the flowers out with the punch.
5. Adhere the largest flower to each white square. Lay the remaining flowers on the Stampin' Pierce Mat and press the centers with a styles tool or a pen that is closed. This will make the flowers 'pop' up. Adhere each on top of each flower. Reserve (2) flowers for later.
6. Adhere to the (2) 3" x 6" Berry Burst folded cards to the 3 ¼" White pieces. These cards can open any way you want so adhere them in the direction you want them to be on the card.
7. Stamp small sets of flowers in Memento Black and Tahitian Tide on the bottom right corner of the 2 ¾" Basic White; adhere inside Berry Burst cards.
8. Stamp large sentiment in the bottom right corner of (1) 2 ¾" Fresh Freesia and adhere to the bottom left card. Stamp smaller sentiment in the upper Left corner of the remaining Fresh Freesia. Place inside of an embossing folder so that the sentiment is sticking out at the top; run through machine. Adhere the ⅛" x 3" across the seam and snip off ends. Adhere to the upper right corner of card.
9. Add flowers and gems.
10. Create envelope with the 8 ½" x 8 ½" copy paper following **DIAGRAM C**.
11. Stamp on the front of envelope, if desired.



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Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Earthen Textures Bundle
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Pecan Pie, Blackberry Bliss, Very Vanilla
- **Stampin' Pads:** Blackberry Bliss, VersaMark
- **Other:** Paper Trimmer, Bone Folder, Timber 3D Embossing Folder, Heat Tool, Metallics Embossing Powder (copper), Die Cutting Machine, Adhesive Sheet, Stampin' Dimensionals

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Pecan Pie:** 5 1/4" x 8 3/4" (Diagram A)
 - 3" x 6", score and fold at 3"
 - 3" x 3"
 - 3/4" x 7"
 - Scraps for die cutting leaves
 - 8 1/2" x 8 1/2"
- **Blackberry Bliss:** (2) 3 1/4" x 3 1/4"
 - (7) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"
 - Scrap for die cutting pot
- **Very Vanilla:** (3) 2 3/4" x 2 3/4"
- **Adhesive Sheet:** 3/4" x 7"
- **Cardboard:** 4 5/8" x 4 5/8"

Card Instructions:

1. On the scrap Blackberry Bliss, stamp the pot in Versamark ink, sprinkle with embossing powder, heat set with heat tool. Set aside to cool.
2. Stamp sentiment in the upper right corner of (1) Very Vanilla in Blackberry Bliss ink. Stamp (3) trees underneath in VersaMark. Sprinkle with embossing powder and heat set with heat tool. Adhere to the 3" x 3" Pecan Pie. Set aside.
3. Run the 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" Blackberry Bliss cardstock through the embossing folder. Run all (7) 1 ½" squares of Blackberry Bliss through the embossing folder.
4. Die cut (3) leaves from the scraps of Pecan Pie cardstock. Die cut the pot.
5. Place the ¾" x 7" Adhesive Sheet on the back of the ¾" x 7" Pecan Pie and die cut (4) XX dies.
6. Follow the instructions on **DIAGRAM A** to create the card base.
7. Burnish all the score lines with a bone folder:
 - Burnish the (2) center score lines inward.
 - The top score will fold towards the back.
 - The bottom score will fold towards the front.
 - When the card is laying flat, it will look like **DIAGRAM B** with the bottom left panel on the front.
8. Adhere the (7) 1 ½" squares to the card base.
9. Adhere the 3" x 3" Pecan Pie/embossed image to the upper right corner with Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Adhere the 3" x 6" card, with the opening towards the right, on the bottom left corner. Adhere a Very Vanilla on top. Adhere the leaves and add pot with Stampin' Dimensionals.
11. Stamp sentiment on the remaining Very Vanilla and add to inside of card.
12. Peel off the backings of the XX dies and adhere on every other Blackberry Bliss square.
13. Create envelope with the 8 ½" x 8 ½" Pecan Pie cardstock following **DIAGRAM C**.
14. Stamp on the front of envelope, if desired.

DIAGRAM A (Card Base): 5 ¼" x 8 ¾"

- With the 8 ¾" at the top, **SCORE** at 3 ½" and 5 ¼"
- Adhere the 3 ¼" x 3 ¼" cardstock as shown
- With the 8 ¾" at the top, line up at 1 ¾" and **SCORE** down 1 ¾" (just above the square cardstock). Rotate cardstock 180° and repeat.
- With the 5 ¼" at the top, line up at 1 ¾" and **CUT** from one score line to the other. Rotate cardstock 180° and repeat.

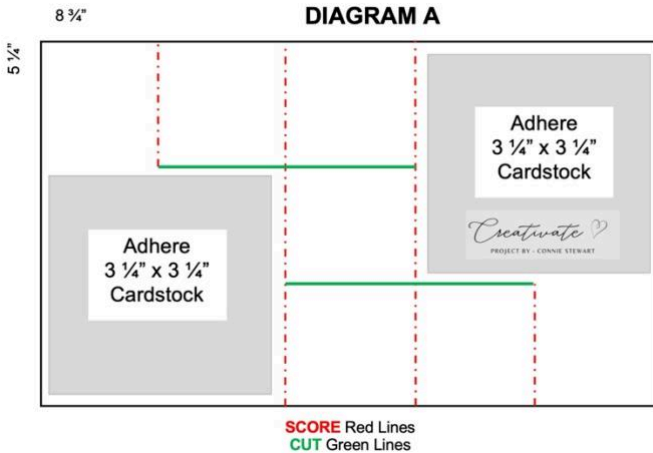


DIAGRAM B:

- Folded, your card should look like this.

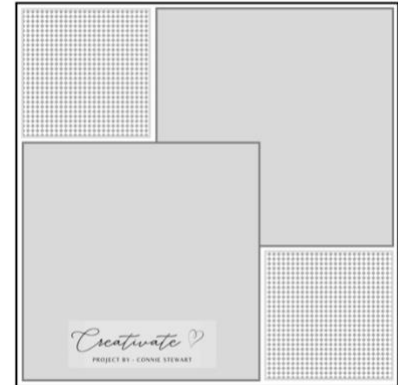


DIAGRAM C:

- 8 ½" x 8 ½" paper of choice
- To create an envelope template, cut the 4 ⅝" x 4 ⅝" cardboard into (2) triangles. Write on the template '5 ½" x 5 ½" Envelope Template – 8 ½" x 8 ½" Paper'. Save this to use again next time you create this card.
- Lay the template in the corner of the 8 ½" x 8 ½" paper and with the bone folder, score along the edge of the template. Repeat this on all (4) corners.
- Trim off the (4) small triangles on all sides.
- Gently burnish the score lines with Bone Folder.
- Fold (2) opposite flaps to the center and adhere together. Bring the bottom flap up and adhere on all outside edges.
- Stamp on the front of envelope, if desired.
- Insert card and adhere all outside edges the envelope to seal it closed.
- This card will require extra postage to mail.
