**Supplies:**

- **Stamps:** Impressions Abloom, More Messages
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Floral Impressions Designer Series Paper (DSP), Secret Sea, Granny Apple Green, Basic Beige, Basic White
- **Stampin' Pads:** Strawberry Slush, Darling Duckling, Secret Sea
- **Other:** Impressions Abloom Dies, More Messages Die, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice, Basic White Medium Envelope

**Cutting & Scoring Instructions:**

- **Basic Beige:**
  - (card base - left side) 11" x 4 ¼", scored at 5 ½"
  - (card base – right side) 6 ½" x 4 ¼", scored at 1"
- **DSP:** (2 pieces) 5 ¼" x 4"
- **Basic White:** (inside) 5 ¼" x 4"
- **Scraps:** Granny Apple Green, Secret Sea, Basic White

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### Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Cheerful Daisies + Coordinating Dies
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Fresh as a Daisy Designer Series Paper, Pebbled Path, Wild Wheat, Basic White
- **Stampin' Pads:** Pebbled Path, Wild Wheat
- **Other:** Linen Thread, Dimensionals, Mini Dimensionals, Mini Glue Dot, Adhesive of Choice

### Card Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Pebbled Path - Card Base (left side):** 11" x 4 1/4", scored at 5 1/2"
- **Pebbled Path - Card Base (right side):** 6 1/2" x 4 1/4", scored at 1"
- **Basic White (inside):** 5 1/4" x 4"
- **DSP:** (2) 5 1/4" x 4"
- **Scraps:** Basic White, Wild Wheat



## Instructions:

- For the left side of the card base, score the 11" x 4 1/4" piece of Pebbled Path at 5 1/2" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom left corner to the top of the score line (see above diagram)
- For the right side, score the 6 1/2" x 4 1/4" piece of Pebbled Path at 1" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom right corner to the top of the score line (see above diagram)
- Adhere the 1" section of the right side to the back of the left side piece (on the right side). Make sure to have the score line right up to the right edge of the left side piece. This creates the **CRISS CROSS** card base
- Cut each of the two pieces of DSP on the diagonal to fit the two criss cross panels. (pay attention to the way the piece of DSP will adhere to the "flap" to ensure you are cutting at the correct angle)
- Adhere the two pieces of DSP to the two flaps
- From Basic White scrap, cut two of each of the dies shown in the photo below
  - Use paper snips to cut the leaves off of both of the #1 die-cut pieces
  - Use paper snips to cut one of the #1 die-cut pieces into three individual daisies
  - Adhere all three #2 pieces to the **BACK** of the #1 pieces
  - Adhere all of the #3 pieces to the **FRONT** of the #1 pieces
- On scrap of Basic White, stamp four small daisy centers and two large daisy centers in Wild Wheat - cut out with paper snips or dies (I find it's easier to cut with the paper snips)
- Adhere the daisy centers using mini dimensionals
- From Wild Wheat scrap, cut four branches
- On scrap of Basic White, stamp greeting in Pebbled Path and cut out with label die
- Assemble card (including inside) as shown, using dimensionals under all of the daisies on the front
- Take two strands of Linen Thread and tie into a bow. Adhere using Mini Glue Dot





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### Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Sweetest Cherries + Cherry Builder Punch
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Soft Sea Foam Designer Series Paper (from Subtles pack), Soft Sea Foam, Basic White
- **Stampin' Pads:** Real Red, Garden Green, Pecan Pie
- **Other:** Deckled Rectangles Dies, Linen Thread, Dimensionals, Mini Glue Dot, Adhesive of Choice

### Card Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Soft Sea Foam - Card Base (left side):** 11" x 4 1/4", scored at 5 1/2"
- **Soft Sea Foam - Card Base (right side):** 6 1/2" x 4 1/4", scored at 1"
- **Basic White (inside):** 5 1/4" x 4"
- **DSP:** 5 1/4" x 4"
- **Scraps:** Basic White, Pecan Pie

## Instructions:

- For the left side of the card base, score the 11" x 4 ¼" piece of Soft Sea Foam at 5 ½" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom left corner to the top of the score line (see diagram for card #1)
- For the right side, score the 6 ½" x 4 ¼" piece of Soft Sea Foam at 1" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom right corner to the top of the score line (see diagram for card #1)
- Adhere the 1" section of the right side to the back of the left side piece (on the right side). Make sure to have the score line right up to the right edge of the left side piece. This creates the CRISS CROSS card base
- Cut the DSP on the diagonal to fit the two criss cross panels. (You will be using both sides. Once you cut, it will "flip" for the other side so pay attention to the way you are cutting to get the design you want on the left and on the right)
- Adhere the two pieces of DSP to the two flaps
- On scrap of Basic White, stamp and punch the following:
  - 5 cherries in Real Red
  - 8 leaves in Garden Green
- From Pecan Pie scrap, punch 5 stems
- Assemble the five cherries as shown (I used scotch tape on the back to adhere the stem and the leaves)
- On scrap of Basic White, stamp greeting in Pecan Pie and cut out with Deckled Rectangles die
- On right front flap, stamp "sweet" in Pecan Pie
- Assemble card as shown, using dimensionals under all of the cherries and the greeting
- Take two strands of Linen Thread and tie into a bow. Adhere using Mini Glue Dot
- Stamp inside as shown and adhere to inside of card



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### Supplies:

- **Stamps:** He's All That + Coordinating Dies
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Pecan Pie Designer Series Paper (from 2023-2025 In Color pack), Pecan Pie, Pebbled Path, Basic White
- **Stampin' Pads:** Pecan Pie, Pebbled Path
- **Other:** Stylish Shapes Dies, In Color Dots, Linen Thread, Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice

### Card Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Pecan Pie - Card Base (left side):** 11" x 4 ¼", scored at 5 ½"
- **Pecan Pie - Card Base (right side):** 6 ½" x 4 ¼", scored at 1"
- **Basic White (inside):** 5 ¼" x 4"
- **DSP:** (2) 5 ¼" x 4" + ½" x 5 ¼" strip for inside
- **Scraps:** Basic White, Pebbled Path

## Instructions:

- For the left side of the card base, score the 11" x 4 1/4" piece of Pecan Pie at 5 1/2" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom left corner to the top of the score line (see diagram for card #1)
- For the right side, score the 6 1/2" x 4 1/4" piece of Pecan Pie at 1" then use your paper trimmer to cut from the bottom right corner to the top of the score line (see diagram for card #1)
- Adhere the 1" section of the right side to the back of the left side piece (on the right side). Make sure to have the score line right up to the right edge of the left side piece. This creates the CRISS CROSS card base
- Cut each of the two pieces of DSP on the diagonal to fit the two criss cross panels. (pay attention to the way the piece of DSP will adhere to the "flap" to ensure you are cutting at the correct angle)
- Adhere the two pieces of DSP to the two flaps
- On scrap of Basic White, stamp the two front images (one for each flap) in Pebbled Path and cut out with die
- From scrap of Pebbled Path, die-cut the banner (from the He's All That dies) and the stitched circle (from the Stylish Shapes dies)
- Adhere the "together for the long haul" image to the banner using dimensionals. Wrap two strands of Linen thread around the left side of the banner and tie into a bow. Adhere this unit to the left flap of the card front using dimensionals (be careful to not put dimensionals where it overhangs the edge)
- Add three In Color Dot embellishments
- Adhere the compass image to the stitched circle, then to the right flap of the card using dimensionals (be careful to not put dimensionals where it overhangs the edge). TIP: be sure this image is placed low enough to be hidden behind the top flap/greeting
- Adhere the 1/2" strip to the top of the Basic White piece for the inside
- Stamp inside image in Pebbled Path, then adhere layer to inside of card
