

## Challenge #3 Bonus Projects



### Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Peace on Earth
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper (DSP), Cloud Cover, Crumb Cake, Basic White
- **Stampin' Pads:** Secret Sea
- **Other:** Peace on Earth Dies, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice, Basic White Medium Envelope

### Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Crumb Cake:**
  - (card base) 8 ½" x 5 ½" scored 4 ¼"
  - Large die-cut label
- **Cloud Cover:** (front layer) 4" x 5 ¼"
- **Basic White:** (inside) 4" x 5 ¼"
- **DSP:**
  - (5 pieces) 3 ½" x 1"
  - (envelope) 6" x 2 ½"
- **Scraps:** Cloud Cover, Basic White

## Instructions:

- Adhere the five DSP strips as shown to the Cloud Cover layer
- Adhere layer to card front
- On a scrap of Cloud Cover, stamp sentiment and die cut with the smaller label die
- Adhere to larger Crumb Cake label, then to card using Stampin' Dimensionals
- From a scrap of Basic White, die cut the bird and attach as shown using Stampin' Dimensionals
- Stamp inside as shown and adhere to inside of the card
- Adhere DSP to the envelope flap and trim off excess





### Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Delicate Pines
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Basic White Thick, Nests of Winter Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- **Stampin' Pads:** Secret Sea
- **Other:** Black & White & Gold Baker's Twine, Dear Dots, Scissors, Stampin' Dimensionals, Adhesive of Choice, Basic White Medium Envelope

### Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Basic White:**
  - (card base) 5 ½" x 8 ½", score at 4 ¼"
  - (strip layer) 5 ¼" x 4"
  - (sentiment) 6" x ¾"
- **DSP:**
  - (5) (front strips) 1" x 3 ½"
  - (inside strip) 5 ¼" x 1"
  - (envelope) 6" x 2 ½"
- **Scraps:** DSP

## Instructions:

- Cut, score, and fold the Basic White card base.
- Adhere one of the DSP strips to the left side of the Basic White layer, keeping a ¼” border around the top, bottom, and left edges.
- Adhere two more DSP strips of the same pattern, one on the right side and the other in the middle, keeping the same border around the edges.
- Adhere the reverse side of the remaining two DSP strips between the other strips, alternating the patterns as pictured.
- Use Secret Sea to stamp the front sentiment on the Basic White strip as pictured.
- Wrap a double strand of White & Gold Baker’s Twine around the sentiment strip and tie a decorative bow.
- Adhere the sentiment across the bottom portion of the Basic White front layer using Stampin’ Dimensionals. Then, wrap both ends around to the back and adhere to secure in place.
- Center and adhere the layered image to the card front as pictured.
- Adhere the inside DSP strip to the inside bottom of the card, leaving an even border along the bottom and both sides as pictured.
- Use scissors to cut out two birds, a pinecone, and leaves. Then, adhere the images to the card front and inside the card as pictured.
- Stamp a sentiment on the inside of the card using Secret Sea.
- Embellish the card with Dear Dots.

For a coordinating envelope, adhere the DSP envelope layer to the flap and trim excess





### Supplies:

- **Cardstock/Paper:** Strawberry Slush, Basic White, Pretty in Pink, Florals in Bloom Designer Series Paper & Sticker Sheet (DSP)
- **Stampin' Pads:** Pretty in Pink
- **Other:** Strawberry Slush Textured Ribbon, Mini Glue Dots, Adhesive of Choice, Basic White Medium Envelope

### Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Granny Apple Green:** (card base) 8 ½" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼"
- **Designer Series Paper (DSP):**
  - (front layer strips): (3) 1" x 3 ½" (florals)
  - (front layer strips): (2) 1" x 3 ½" (pattern)
  - (envelope): 6" x 2 ½"
- **Basic White:** (2) (front layer & inside layer) 5 ¼" x 4"

## Instructions:

- Adhere the Basic White front layer to the card base.
- Begin adding the strips, alternating with florals and pattern DSP, to the card front with adhesive.
- Adhere a greeting from the Sticker Sheet. Add a leaf image underneath it.
- Adhere a sentiment from the Sticker Sheet. Add a floral image in the bottom right corner.
- Adhere inside of the card.
- Add DSP to the envelope flap and trim
