Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Love and Courage
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Pretty in Pink, Basic White, 2024-2026 In Color 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (DSP)
- **Stampin' Pads:** Pretty in Pink
- **Other:** Bone Folder, Adhesive of Choice, Dimensionals, Basic White Envelope

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Pretty in Pink:**
 - (card base): 11" x 5 ½", scored at 4 ¼", 5 ½", 6 ¾"
 - (front layer): 3 ½" x 3 ¾"
 - (left inside pop-up section): 4 ¼" x 3", score at ½", 3 ¼", 3 ¾"
 - (right inside pop-up section): 5" x 5 ½", score at ½", 4", 4 ½"
- **Designer Series Paper:**
 - (front layer): 4" x 5 ¼"
 - (pop-up inside layer): 2 ½" x 2 ¾"
 - (envelope): 6" x 2 ½"
- **Basic White:**
 - (front greeting layer): 3 ¼" x 3 ½"
 - (inside layer): 3 ¼" x 5"
 - (inside greeting layer): 1 ½" x 2 ½"
 - (inside strips): (2) ½" x 5 ½"



Instructions for assembling the basic Platform Pop-Up Card:

- Make a mountain fold on the center score line of the card base.
- Fold the next score line backwards in a valley fold.
- Make another valley fold on the remaining score line. Crease all folds well with a bone folder.
- Create mountain folds on all the score lines of both pop-up pieces. Crease all folds well with the Bone Folder.
- **Left pop-up section:** Flatten the piece so that you can see the scored sections. Position the pop-up to the left of the middle of the card. The single scored section that forms a “tab” should be closest to the middle fold.
- Put adhesive on the single “tab” on the right. Nestle the edge of the tab to the left side of the middle fold at the valley score line.
- Press down on the right side of the pop-up so that the piece adheres to the middle fold.
- Fold the two scored sections on the left side of the pop-up back so that they are flat on the backside of the pop-up. Place adhesive **ONLY** on the tab on the outer edge.
- Fold the left side of the card base closed and press to adhere the pop-up to the card base.
- **Right Pop-Up Section:** Next, you will attach the right pop-up section. Flatten the piece so that you can see the scored sections. Position the remaining pop-up to the right of the center of the card.
- Position the piece so that one scored section forms a “tab” on the left side, next to the middle fold.
- Place adhesive on the tab.
- Position the pop-up in the center of the right inside of the card. Lightly nestle the edge of the tab against the center section and double-check the alignment. Close the card and press on the back side of the section of the middle fold where the pop-up is adhered.
- Fold the two scored sections of the pop-up back so that they are flat on the backside of the pop-up.
- Place adhesive **ONLY** on the outside tab.
- Fold the right side of the card base closed and press to adhere the tab to the inside of the card base

Instructions to finish the card:

- Stamp a heart and ribbon on the Basic White inside layer with Pretty in Pink, and add it to the right pop-up section with adhesive. (Note: position the left edge flush with the left edge of the pop-up section)
- Add the inside strips to the left and right sides with adhesive
- Stamp the greeting on the inside greeting layer and add to the pop-up inside layer DSP
- Add the pop-up inside layer DSP to the left side with adhesive
- Add the front layer of DSP to the card front with adhesive
- Adhere the stamped greeting layer to the Pretty in Pink front layer and add both to the card front with Dimensionals
- Adhere DSP to the envelope flap, trim with scissors





Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Traditional Labels
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Real Red, Basic White, Traditions of Christmas Designer Series Paper (DSP), Gold Foil, Old Olive
- **Stampin' Pads:** Secret Sea, VersaMark, Real Red
- **Other:** Bone Folder, Traditional Labels Dies, Metallics WOW! Embossing Powder, Heat tool, Embossing Additions Tool Kit, Adhesive of Choice, Dimensionals, Basic White Envelope

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Real Red:**
 - (card base): 11" x 5 1/2", scored at 4 1/4", 5 1/2", 6 3/4"
 - (left inside pop-up section): 4 1/4" x 3", score at 1/2", 3 1/4", 3 3/4"
 - (right inside pop-up section): 5" x 5 1/2", score at 1/2", 4", 4 1/2"
- **Designer Series Paper:**
 - (front layer): 4" x 5 1/4"
 - (pop-up inside layer): 2 1/2" x 2 3/4"
 - (inside strips): (2) 1/2" x 5 1/2"
 - (envelope): 6" x 2 1/2"
- **Basic White:**
 - (front greeting & image layer): scrap
 - (inside layer): 3 1/4" x 5"
- **Old Olive:** scrap for greenery
- **Gold Foil:** scrap for greenery

Complete the Instructions for assembling the basic Platform Pop-Up Card from the previous card.

Instructions to finish the card:

- Stamp the Basic White inside layer with Secret Sea, and add it to the right pop-up section with adhesive. (Note: position the left edge flush with the left edge of the pop-up section)
- Add the inside strips of DSP to the left and right sides with adhesive
- Add the pop-up inside layer DSP to the inside left side pop-up section with adhesive
- Add the front layer of DSP to the card front with adhesive
- Rub Embossing Buddy over Basic White scrap, stamp poinsettia spray with VersaMark, pour gold embossing powder over, and heat set
- Stamp poinsettia with Real Red ink, and use the die to cut out the image. Adhere the Poinsettia spray with adhesive
- Use dies to cut out Old Olive and Gold Foil greenery – two of each
- Add greenery pieces to the back of the poinsettia spray die cut with adhesive, and add all to the card front with Dimensionals
- Stamp greeting with Secret Sea on Basic White scrap, cut out with die, and add to card front with adhesive
- Adhere DSP to the envelope flap, trim with scissors





Supplies:

- **Stamps:** Sunrise Sailing, Label Me Grateful
- **Cardstock/Paper:** Misty Moonlight, Basic White, Timeless Plaid 6" x 6" Designer Series Paper (DSP), Basic Gray
- **Stampin' Pads:** Misty Moonlight, Basic Gray
- **Other:** Bone Folder, Sunrise Sailing Dies, Blending Brush, Adhesive of Choice, Dimensionals, Basic White Envelope

Cutting & Scoring Instructions:

- **Misty Moonlight:**
 - (card base): 11" x 5 1/2", scored at 4 1/4", 5 1/2", 6 3/4"
 - (front layer): 3 1/4" x 4 3/4"
 - (left inside pop-up section): 4 1/4" x 3", score at 1/2", 3 1/4", 3 3/4"
 - (right inside pop-up section): 5" x 5 1/2", score at 1/2", 4", 4 1/2"
- **Designer Series Paper:**
 - (front layer): 4" x 5 1/4"
 - (pop-up inside layer): 2 1/2" x 2 3/4"
 - (inside strips): (2) 1/2" x 5 1/2"
 - (envelope): 6" x 2 1/2"
- **Basic White:**
 - (front image layer): 3" x 4 1/2"
 - (front greeting layer): 2 1/4" x 1 1/2"
 - (inside layer): 3 1/4" x 5"
 - (inside image layer): scrap for sail
- **Basic Gray:** scrap for sailboat

Complete the Instructions for assembling the basic Platform Pop-Up Card from the first card.

Instructions to finish the card:

- Stamp the Basic White inside layer with Misty Moonlight, and add it to the right pop-up section with adhesive. Note: position the left edge flush with the left edge of the pop-up section)
- Add the inside strips to the left and right sides with adhesive
- Add the pop-up inside layer DSP to the left pop-up section with adhesive
- Use dies to cut the sail from the Basic White scrap and the sailboat from the Basic Gray scrap, adhere both together, and add to the DSP on the left pop-up section with adhesive
- Add the front layer of DSP to the card front with adhesive
- Stamp Sailboat with Misty Moonlight on Basic White image layer
- Ink up the sail image with Misty Moonlight and stamp off once before stamping on the sail
- Stamp boat with Basic Gray ink
- Stamp water with Misty Moonlight and lightly add the same ink with the Blending Brush
- Adhere the stamped image layer to the Misty Moonlight front layer and add both to the card front with Dimensionals
- Stamp greeting with Misty Moonlight and add to the card front with adhesive
- Adhere DSP to the envelope flap, trim with scissors
